To amend section 236A of the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to the requirement to cross reference the terrorist screening database.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Identifying Potential
- 5 Terrorist at the Border Act of 2025".
